

Suzhou Xiangcheng Germany SCI-TECH Innovation Conference

Suzhou Xiangcheng Germany SCI-Tech Innovation Conference was successfully held in Munich on September 15th.



This is the second time that Xiangcheng has taken the initiative to contact the international community since it successfully held the technology and finance investment promotion conference in San Francisco, the U.S. in May.



At the conference, Business Development Director Yannick Schutten, on behalf of EU Sino, signed the Innovation Start up Village project with the Technology and Business Bureau of Suzhou High-Speed Railway New City(HSR).

Suzhou HSR has established the cooperation with several German universities and institutes on the R&D projects and will introduce high-quality projects that are interested in settling down in Xiangcheng.

Xiangcheng Government has the intention to introduce a large number of quality projects.

Suzhou National Square Automotive Eletronics Co. Ltd. and Woocal Automotive Technology(GmbH) had an agreement to set up an automotive electronics laboratory in Germany.

Xiangcheng Economic and Technology Development Zone signed the contract with EU China High-Level Talent Exchange Center to bring more talents specialized in Sci-Tech sector.







The Overseas Talents Affairs Office of Xiangcheng Huangdai High-tech Zone was also one of the projects in Germany. It is not only the incubator of the innovation and entrepreneurship program for the Overseas Chinese in Germany, but also the bridge for German enterprises to explore the Chinese market.

This year, EU Sino helped Infoteam to expand in China. Micheal Hackl, general manager of Infoteam in Suzhou, was also invited to make a speech at the conference.

The reason why Infoteam chose to settle down in Xiangcheng was because of its convenient location and transportation, as well as the favorable investment environment and development potential of "five



functional zones" in Xiangcheng. "We have great confidence in the future development and believe that we will achieve mutual benefit and win-win results with each other through in-depth strategic cooperation." explained Micheal.

On March 27th this year, Infoteam signed the official agreement with Xiangcheng government to set up China's first industry 4.0 software design company in Xiangcheng district, providing advanced software solutions for various automation applications.



Established in 2001, Xiangcheng is located at the center of Suzhou. The district covers an area of 489 km2 and has a total population of 1.07 million. The economy continued to grow rapidly and is the most active area. Since its establishment, Xiangcheng GDP grew by an average of more than 16%, the general public budget revenue grew by an average of more than 25%, total import and export increased by 22% annually, and 629 foreign enterprises have invested here.
